The 2024 Awards recognise and celebrate the many people and organisations contributing to sustainably managing and protecting the coastal and marine environment across Victoria.

The Awards highlight the importance of community and partnerships in making sure the values of Victoria's marine and coastal areas are maintained and enhanced for the future.

The Awards bring together the marine and coastal sector to celebrate our treasured coast and marine areas.

These prestigious awards have been running for over 25 years (previously under the Victorian Coastal Council; now under the Victorian Marine and Coastal Council) and are a highlight for the marine and coastal sector in Victoria. There are seven categories for nominations:

- Leadership in Climate Adaptation and Resilience
- Excellence in Marine and Coastal Design or Development
- Distinction in Biodiversity and Ecosystem Conservation
- Inspiring Community Engagement and Education
- Marine and Coastal Stewardship by Private Landowners or Public Lease/Licence Holders
- Recognising Individual Achievement and Emerging Leadership
- Embedding Traditional Owner Cultural Practices in Management

Nominations are encouraged from individuals, groups, Traditional Owners, schools, universities, students, clubs (including fishing, boating and lifesaving), committees of management, private companies, partnerships, not-for-profit organisations, private landowners, lease/licence holders and local councils and state government organisations, just to name a few.
